



Peoria Public Schools COVID-19 Metrics (through Friday, Feb. 19)

Below are the COVID-19 metrics for Peoria Public Schools. It is important to note that these metrics are pulled through Friday, Feb. 19th and are a snapshot of a moment in time. These numbers will continue to fluctuate on a daily basis.

Our metrics show the active number of staff and student positives in the district along with a percentage highlighting the rate of those positive cases as a part of the total staff in our district and total students taking part in in-person instruction in the district. We have more than 2,000 staff members throughout the district and more than 9,000 students currently on the Hybrid schedule doing in-person instruction.

Here are a few definitions to remember as you navigate these metrics.

What is an active positive case? An active positive case is someone we are monitoring who has received a positive test result within 48 hours of the positive test being administered or 48 prior to the symptoms onset prior to the positive test.

What is an exclusion? An exclusion occurs when someone has been possibly exposed to a confirmed positive case, or if they develop a COVID-like symptom, defined as: Fever (100.4°F or higher), headache, shortness of breath, cough, sore throat, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain/stomachache, congestion or runny nose, new loss of sense of taste or smell, nausea, fatigue, muscle or body aches.
