OUR PROGRAMS

Barbering

The history, technology, and art of barbering, including treatment of hair and scalp and men's hair cutting and styling. (barbering license opportunity)

Collision Technology/Autobody

An introduction to the auto body/collision repair industry, including welding and automotive refinishing. (paint certificate opportunity)

Construction

Tools, safety, basic electrical, plumbing, building concepts and design, with a variety of construction projects. (opportunities for construction trades certificates)

Construction Industry Work-Based Learning

Next-level exposure to the construction industry, including recognized credentials and workplace internships. (OSHA, forklift operator safety, and first aid/CPR certificate opportunities)

OUR PROGRAMS

Cosmetology

An introduction to the beauty industry: practical skills, tools and equipment, nail technology, skin care, women's hair cuts and styling. (cosmetology license opportunity)

Criminal Justice

A dual-credit program with a basic overview of law and law enforcement, including corrections, criminal justice, investigations, and policing. (first aid/CPR certificate opportunity)

Culinary Arts and Hospitality Management

A foundation for a culinary or hospitality career: classroom studies, cooking techniques, hands-on kitchen experience, knife skills, and an introduction to table service. (ServSafe certification opportunity and articulated credit with ICC)

Emergency Services/ Fire Science Technology

A two-year dual-credit program, including an introduction to firefighting tactics and strategies, emergency medical response procedures, and fire prevention. (opportunities for first aid/CPR and EMT certifications)

Hair Braiding

The history of hair braiding, with a focus on tools, products, styles, extensions, professional ethics, and business practices. (hair braiding license opportunity)

Health Occupations

A dual-credit program focusing upon foundational skills in healthcare, an introduction to human biology, medical terminology, and nursing assistant training. (first aid/CPR certification and CNA license opportunities)

Information Technology/ Coding

A dual-credit program featuring beginning and intermediate web development, creation of web pages, graphics, web project management, cyber security, and programming. (cyber security certification opportunity)
