OUR PROGRAMS

Accounting/Bookkeeping

A dual-credit class, preparing students for employment in accounting/bookkeeping, clerical, or word processing positions.

Skill-building courses include Survey of Accounting, Telephone Skills for the Office, PowerPoint, Outlook, Electronic Spreadsheets, Keyboard/Word Processing, Data Entry, and Accounting/Bookkeeping Internship. (Microsoft Office certifications opportunities)

Early Childhood Education

A dual-credit program preparing students for employment in the Early Childhood Education field. This includes Introduction to Child Development, Human Growth & Development, Early Childhood Programs, and Child, Family, and Community courses. (opportunities for first aid/CPR certification and advanced early childhood credentials)

Entrepreneurship

A dual-credit program, preparing students to operate their own businesses, instilling the determination and creative drive to be their own boss. Skill-building courses include Business Communications, Telephone Skills for the Office, PowerPoint, Outlook, Electronic Spreadsheets, Keyboard/Word Processing, Data Entry, and Business internship. (Microsoft Office certifications opportunities)

OUR PROGRAMS

Graphic Communications

A dual-credit program featuring hands-on techniques and skills in typography, graphic communications, web page development, image manipulation, design considerations, screen printing, printing methods, page layout, and digital desktop publishing. (opportunities for first aid/CPR certification and advanced education credentials)

Horticulture/Landscape Design

A dual-credit program preparing students for employment in the landscape management industry. Theory is taught in the classroom and applied in outdoor laboratories: plants, pruning, garden flowers, plant disease and insect control, soil fertility, horticulture business management, irrigation, and landscape design and construction. (opportunities for first aid/CPR certification and advanced education credentials)

Nail Technology

A program training students in all aspects of manicuring, pedicuring, and professional nail application. This includes studies of the structure, growth, diseases and conditions of the nail, as well as anatomy, nail care, and salon ownership and management. (nail technology license opportunity)

OUR PROGRAMS

Office Occupations

A dual-credit program preparing students for employment in clerical or word-processing positions. Skill-building courses include Telephone Skills for the Office, Outlook, Electronic Spreadsheets, Keyboard/Word Processing, Data Entry, and Office Occupations Internship. (Microsoft Office certifications opportunities)

Renewable Energy

A dual-credit program preparing students for entry-level positions in the renewable energy field. Students will learn renewable energy concepts and basic skills in electrical technology, industrial and building controllers, and mechanical systems. With these skills, students can install, troubleshoot, and repair various renewable energy systems. (opportunity for OSHA 30 certification)

Teacher Education Pathway

A dual-credit program preparing students for employment in the education field. This includes Teaching Diverse Populations, Introduction to American Education, Diverse Learners in the Classroom, and Field Experience in Education. (opportunities for first aid/CPR certification and advanced education credentials)
