




What is Pinpoint?

The Pinpoint platform will provide the Peoria Public School District with a Learning Management System designed to be an integrated instructional and management tool that will improve academic outcomes, personnel workflows, and the educational experiences of students, teachers, and administrators. The Pinpoint implementation will include five modules: Instruction/Curriculum/Assessment, Analytics, Professional Development, Teacher Evaluate, and Gradebook which will be rolled out in a phased approach.



Module 1: Instruction/Curriculum/Assessment

Pinpoint Instruction delivers a powerful combination of educational tools for teachers and administrators to develop, deliver, assess, remediate, and manage instruction. It's a central hub for all levels, types, and styles of curriculum mapping, resources, and assessments enhanced by a standards-aligned content repository.

- Allows for creating, administering, scoring and reporting on district and classroom level assessments




Figure 1: Curriculum Management View




Figure 2: Teacher Instruction View

Module 2: Analytics

The Analytics Module enables predictive, data-driven decisions. It becomes the centerpiece of school improvement plans and professional data-driven learning communities. Pinpoint Analytics enables you to query data that has been collected across multiple years and classrooms and share those findings with all stakeholders.

Module 3: Professional Development

Targeted and effective online professional development is built into Pinpoint, providing an opportunity to transition staff to digital-age learning. The PD Module enables teachers to access integrated job-embedded professional learning. With Pinpoint Professional Development, teachers and students can work and learn together using the same online platform preparing them for the immediate challenges faced in the 21st century classroom.

Module 4: Teacher Evaluate

The Pinpoint Teacher Evaluate module is an online professional development tool which allows administrators to evaluate teacher effectiveness and track teacher progress against district goals and standards.

Module 5: Gradebook

Pinpoint Gradebook tracks and manages classroom data. Pinpoint's Gradebook is also a comprehensive, standards assessment solution. Student info such as grades, attendance, or test scores can be recorded in Gradebook.

Pinpoint Pilot

All schools will participate in a limited pilot for fall 2012. The Pilot is designed to provide a launch point for a successful rollout to all grades and subjects. Following Pinpoint training, over 150 Pilot teachers will have access to the system for use in their classrooms. Feedback from the Pilot teachers will be used to enhance the experience for the next phase of implementation.
