

Students – Administrative Procedure

Instructional Program for Pregnant Students

When a girl is known to be pregnant, precautions should be taken to protect her health and safety.

1. The principal shall:
 - a. Request a report by the physician describing the activities in which the girl may, or may not participate.
 - b. Advise the student/parents/guardian where the girl may get a free examination if they are in financial need.
2. Advise the student/parents/guardian that home instruction services are available.
3. Advise the student/parents/guardian of the procedure for requesting home instruction services.
 - a. Completion of the request for home tutoring services by the physician
 - b. Forward the signed form to the principal.
 - c. Secondary schools will complete arrangements for home tutoring.
 - d. Elementary schools will forward the request form to the central office (Special Services Division) for completion of arrangements for home instruction.
4. Credit will be allowed for work completed through home/hospital instruction provided by District 150. Credit shall be determined by the individual high school principal for secondary students; credit at the elementary level shall also be determined by the elementary principal.
